

## SAFETY - Please Read !

On Code Red Fire Danger Rating days, Parks and State Forest are closed to the public. Do not enter parks or forests on Code Red Days. If you are already there when a Code Red day is announced, you should leave the night before or early in the morning. For more information contact the Department of Environment and Primary Industries (DEPI).

Be responsible for your own safety. Be aware of extreme weather events, carry your own first aid kit and let someone know before you go.

Pit toilets are common at State Forests but hand washing facilities and toilet paper may not be supplied. Come prepared.

When on forest roads, be prepared for the unexpected. Timber trucks, 4WD's, hikers, horse riders, trail bike riders, cyclists and native animals may also be using your chosen track.
